Professor Farida Fortune Dentistry Post Covid

Professor Fortune is Professor of Medicine in relation to Oral Health in the Centre for Clinical and Diagnostic Oral Sciences (CDOS). She graduated in both Dentistry and Medicine from University College, University of London. In 1992 she obtained her PhD in University of London. She is on the specialist register for Oral Medicine in Dentistry (GDC), and Immunology in Medicine (GMC). She was appointed Senior Lecturer in Immunology and Honorary Consultant in Oral Medicine at UMDS (Guys and St Thomas Hospital). In 1998 she was conferred the title of Professor of Oral Medicine at Leeds University.

In 2002 Professor Fortune was recruited to the position of Professor of Medicine in Relation to Oral Health at Queen Mary. She had previously held the positions of Head of Oral Medicine at Leeds University and Senior Lecturer in Immunology and Honorary Consultant in Oral Medicine at the United Medical and Dental Schools of Guy's and St Thomas' Hospitals.

She was appointed as The Dean and Head and Institute Director of Dentistry for Dentistry at Barts and The London in 2007-2013. She has extensive experience in teaching within both the undergraduate and postgraduate sector. Her expertise is in curriculum development, assessment methodology and quality assurance. She works in these areas both in the UK and abroad. She chaired Royal College of Surgeons examination committee for a number of years. She has being seminal in the reintroduction of the LDS RCSeng., which was the first licensed examination in Dentistry. She is one of the founding members of Interprofessional Education Network of Royal Society of Medicine 2013; Member of (UKHEAC) UK Healthcare Education Advisory Committee.

She works extensively with local communities and mentors' doctors, dentists and scientists trying to navigate the complex environments of the HEIs and NHS.



Aims & Objectives

Dr Linda Greenwall -Transforming Smiles with Additive Dentistry



Dr Greenwall is a Prosthodontist and Specialist in Restorative Dentistry. She lectures in the UK and internationally on tooth whitening, aesthetic dentistry, practice management and inspirational talks. As well as running a multidisciplinary private practice in Hampstead, London, she is a founder member and past Chair of the British Dental Bleaching Society (2008-2013), past chair of the Alpha Omega Society (2012/13), Editor-in-Chief of the journal *Aesthetic Dentistry Today*, and is past President of the Metropolitan London Branch of the British Dental Association (2015/2016). In March 2016 she was awarded the FMC Award for Outstanding Contribution to Dentistry. Linda also helps mentor aspiring dentist achieve their dream of starting dental school.

Her first book, *Bleaching Techniques in Restorative Dentistry*, won the award for Best New Dental Book in 2001 – the new edition of this book, *Tooth Whitening Techniques*, was published in May 2017. Her book *Success Strategies for the Aesthetic Dental Practice* was published by Quintessence in 2011 together with Practice Management Consultant Dr Cathy Jameson. She has written many papers for scientific journals.

In 2011, Dr Greenwall established the Dental Wellness Trust Charity which has the motto "Oral Health through Dental Wellness. The charity runs innovate oral health programmes to the less fortunate Communities and reaches over 15 000 children daily in the townships of South Africa and over 3,500 school children in London, Luton, and South East England.

In June 2017 she was honoured by the Queen in her birthday honours to receive the British Empire Medal for her Service to Dentistry in the UK and Abroad. The medal ceremony was held on 17 November 2017 at the Tower of London and then she attended the Garden Party at Buckingham Palace in 2018.

Course Description: Our Diet and lifestyles contribute to our change in oral health. More patients are being seen with severe tooth wear, whether it is from acid erosion, grinding or enamel defects. Dentists often find embracing new techniques a challenge and implementing change in practice with the team and patients is of great concern. Diagnose Tooth Wear **2.** Comprehensive treatment planning for all patients with Tooth wear which includes laboratory work. **3.** Demonstrate excellent communication skills with patients so they are full understanding of their treatment **4.** Be able to communicate with the laboratory the correct stents and models required for treatment **5.** Discuss how tooth whitening, bondings and 3 step additive technique can restore in a minimal invasive way.

Dr Claire Nightingale Tackling snoring and Obstructive sleep apnoea How dentists can help



Claire Nightingale, a highly experienced and multiple prize winning orthodontist, including "Orthodontist of the Year, London, 2019" in the GHP Private Healthcare Awards, decided to become an orthodontist at the age of 12, having been inspired by experiencing fantastic care from her own dentist. She then qualified as a dentist over 30 years ago, from Newcastle University and completed her specialist training as an orthodontist in 1996, at Bristol University. She is the owner of Queens Gate Orthodontics and combines private practice in South Kensington with an NHS Consultant post at Watford General Hospital.

She has treated thousands of children and adults with fixed braces, and over three hundred patients with Invisalign. In addition to routine orthodontics, her special interests include working with jaw (orthognathic) surgeons to treat people with facial deformity and to relieve the symptoms of obstructive sleep apnoea.

Claire was awarded "Orthodontist of the Year, London" 2019 - 2020 in the GHP Healthcare Awards and is President of the London Dental Fellowship, 2019 - 2020.

She is passionate about orthodontics, and when not treating patients, she is busy lecturing to dental societies, writing textbooks, and training dentists to become orthodontists. At other times, she is running around after her three children and two cats and occasionally gets to play her piano.

Seema is the founder of the Smile Impressions Group of Dental practices, a partner at William Place Dental and Cosmetic Practice and the Managing Director of Dentabyte, her practice management consultancy.

Born in Zambia and educated at the International School of Lusaka (ISL), then at Roedean School for Girls in Brighton, Seema qualified as a dentist from Guys Hospital in 1989. She practised in East London for 20 years, and has established several entrepreneurial start-up dental practices in and around London, winning several early business awards for the rapid growth of her dental practice in Docklands. She cites receiving a business award from Richard Branson at the age of 28 as one of her most memorable career moments.

Typifying her "can-do" attitude, Seema founded her charity <u>Child Action</u>, after visiting Mumbai to star in Channel 4's only overseas episode of Secret Millionaire. Since the charity was founded in 2010, Child Action has made charitable donations of over £350K to support the education and personal development of underprivileged slum and street children in India.

As well as fundraising for 3 grassroots charities in India, Seema strives to inspire young people in the UK to to embrace social entrepreneurship. She facilitated and project managed an innovative collaboration between Child Action and the British Asian Trust, one of the Prince's charities, resulting in the roll out of Enterprise 4 Change, an innovative web-based teaching resource to spark social entrepreneurship throughout junior schools in the UK.

In 2014 Seema undertook a Postgraduate Certificate in Dental Education and spent one year as Honorary Lecturer in Healthcare Entrepreneurship and Management at the Dental Institute, King's College London, supporting the establishment of a leadership and management curriculum.

In recent years Seema's interests have diversified into management training and business strategy, and she completed a 2 year Executive MBA programme at Imperial Business School, London (2014 - 2016) .

Seema is married to <u>Sanjay Sharma</u>, Professor of Cardiology at St Georges Hospital, and they have 2 daughters.

Dr Jaimini Vadgama qualified from King's College London in 2012 and works in private practice in Kent. During her foundation training she gained a Postgraduate Certificate in Primary Dental Care from the University of Kent alongside passing membership examinations for the Faculty of Dental Surgery at the Royal College of Surgeons Edinburgh. She gained her MSc in Implant Dentistry from the University of Warwick in 2017.

She is a member of the teaching faculty at Brighton and Sussex Medical School on their new MSc in Dental Reconstructive Implant Surgery and was involved in the development and teaching of the pilot module on Emerging Technologies.
